CLUB HISTORY

The history of the club started in 1969 when a team was fielded in the old United Church Association for the first time.

In the first year the club played in "tigers" colours on a parklands oval with no change room facilities. We have come a long way since then. In the second year the club adopted the bulldogs colours and moved to the Daws Road High School Oval. The club quickly grew into two teams and soon established itself as a force. Its first premiership was in 1974 B Grade, followed by back to back A Grade Premierships in 1975 and 1976 and the Double Premiership in 1979.

The original church association folded and became the Adelaide and Suburban Association and then in 1980 we joined to the old Glenelg South Football Association. In 1983, the club moved to its present home ground in the parklands and also adopted the current style of footy jumper.

In 1985, ALFC joined the Amateur League and made a quick impact by winning the A6 A Grade Premiership in 1986, the A5 Premiership in 1988 and the A4 Double Premiership in 1991. The C Grade also won the A10 Premiership in 1992. The only recent grand final appearance was in a loss for the B Grade in 2003.

In recent years the club has not achieved the same success as the halcyon years but continues to be competitive and to provide sporting and social facilities for a wide range of people.

Major additions were made to the existing clubrooms in 1991 and they have been continually improved since then to provide excellent facilities for all members and friends, Full details of the history of the club is documented in the book titled "A Bulldog for Me" published in 1994. Copies are available to purchase at the club bar next time you are having a drink.

2004 saw a triumphant return to the glories of past double premierships with the capture of the Division 6 and 6 Reserves flags - the club's first premierships in 12 years. And with the thirds team also competing in the 2004 finals series, the future of the 'Mighty Bulldogs' was again brightening.

Going up a grade is always a challenge and for the A and B Grade to play off in the 2005, A5 Grand Finals was a credit to all involved. However the being runner up in both is no consolation and 2006 was a struggle for the A Grade, up a grade to A4, while the B Grade continued to be competitive. 2006 also saw the introduction of an affiliated Netball club with 4 teams in the SAUCNA competition. The girls adopted the Royal blue, red and white colours for their bodysuits.

After relegation back to A5 in 2007, the club rebuilt and again played off in both A5 and A5 Reserves grand finals. Unfortunately the A Grade was not good enough on the day, but the B Grade thoroughly deserved the A5 Reserves Premiership, the thirteenth Premiership of the clubs history. Netball entered 5 teams and had our 1st premiership for A3 grade.

2008 saw the boys in A4 where they put in a solid effort and maintained their position in A4. Netball fielded 7 teams in the SAUCNA competition and had a successful year with another Premiership this time for A1.

In 2009 we participate in our 40th season, and continue to strive for success on and off the field.

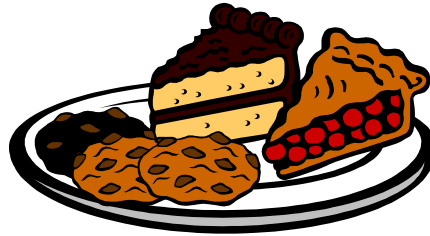

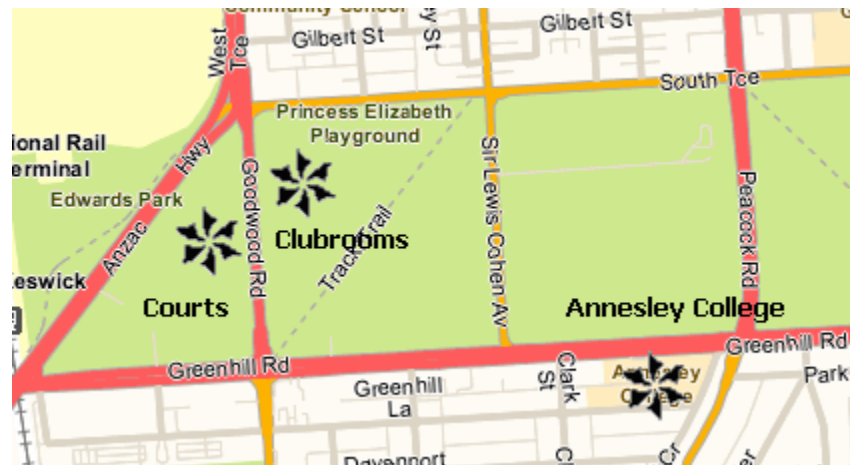
